Minutes of the 3rd Review Meeting held on 27.11.2019 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan, in the matter regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order dated 16.04.2019 and 12.09.2019 in OA no 606/2018

The 3rd Review Meeting regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order dated 16.04.2019 and 12.09.2019 in the matter of OA no. 606/2018 was held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan on 27.11.2019 at 12.30 Noon in Conference Room No. 1 of Government Secretariat. The list of participants is enclosed.

Initiating the discussion, Principal Secretary Environment briefed about the Quarterly compliance report submitted to the Hon'ble NGT on 20.07.2019. The details of the Hon'ble NGT order dated 12.09.2019 were also briefed and it was informed that the desired compliance on thematic areas has also been submitted on time on 01.11.2019 in the prescribed format. Simultaneously orders given by Hon'ble NGT in other cases were also discussed. Following decisions were taken:

Agenda No.1: Review of Department wise progress/ action taken on Hon'ble NGT order dated 16.01.2019 and 16.04.2019 in OA No. 606/2018 (as per Action Plan circulated vide letter dated 30.04.2019).

- I. As per the directions of the Hon'ble NGT contained in the order dated 12.09.2019, the Chief Secretary Rajasthan has to appear before the Tribunal on 31.01.2019 with the updated compliance desired in O.A. 606/2018. It was directed by the Chief Secretary that Review meetings may be organised in the 2nd week of December 2019 and January 2020. Video Conference with the District Collector's may also be held along with the review meetings for getting update of compliance in the districts. (Action: Environment Department)
- ii. Compliance of most of the directions given in the order dated 16.01.2019 and 16.04.2019 has already been made and Action required to be taken has been completed. Therefore, it was decided to exclude this agenda in the next meetings. Only items having long term compliances may be reviewed. (Action: Environment Department)

Agenda No.2: Review of Department wise progress/ action taken on Hon'ble NGT order dated 12.09.2019 in OA No. 606/2018.

i. As directed in the order dated 12.09.2019, information on the thematic areas and variables has been submitted in the prescribed format to the CPCB on 01.11.2019. In future, progress reports may be submitted by all Departments in the thematic areas and variables in the

formats prescribed by CPCB as per Hon'ble Tribunal directions to Environment Department by 5th of every month. (Action: all Departments).

ii. CPCB is required to submit consolidated report of compliance of the Waste Management Rules before the Hon'ble NGT on 15.11.2019 as directed in order dated 12.09.2019. For the same, CPCB has sent special formats for progress of Compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 (106 points query), Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 (15 point queried), E-Waste Management and Hazardous Waste Management; which were to be submitted by 15.11.2019. All concerned Departments were intimated accordingly for submission of the information which has not been received. As the information was elaborate and involved collection of information from all districts, the Departments had sought time for preparation of the information. It was directed that the submission of the information may be expedited as CPCB is required to submit consolidated information to the Hon'ble NGT at the earliest. (Action LSG Department/ Medical & Health Department/ RSPCB)

Agenda No.3: Trend Analysis; Analysis of compliance done by various departments based on reports in April, July and October 2019

- i. Solid Waste Management: As per the information submitted by LSG Department, the numbers of ULBs are 10 less in the compliance of October 2019 as compared to earlier compliances, which is in turn being reflected in all data. Clarification of reduction in the total number of wards may be given in the next compliance report (Action: LSG Department).
- ii. The compliance data regarding Door to door collection, Segregation, Waste processing, etc of all the three compliances is more or less the same over the last 6 months. This may be reviewed and clarified. (Action: LSG Department).
- iii. The reason for no action or action against limited action against the non complying STPS and CETPS may be given. It was directed that Show Cause notices may be served to all Non Complying STPs and also the action under progress may be finalised at the earliest. (Action: LSG Department/ RSPCB)
- iv. Noticing the non increasing and static trend of data, it was directed that in future, cumulative figures of compliance/ progress may be given in the report for each item so that proper assessment of the progress may be done. (Action: all Departments)
- v. Bio-Medical Waste Management: As per the report submitted by the Medical & Health Department, the progress of Inventorisation of HCNs in Bharatpur is very low which may be improved. (Action: Medical & Health Department).
- vi. CTF status of Jaipur is very low which may be improved. (Action: Medical & Health Department).
- vii. Bar Code system installation is nil in Kota and Udaipur and very less in Bikaner, Bharatpur and Jodhpur regions. The progress may be reviewed by the Department and appropriate action be taken for improvement. (Action: Medical & Health Department).

viii. Plastic Waste Management: As per information submitted by the LSG Department, the quantity of seizure of plastic bags is same in July 2019 and September 2019, but the realisation of penalty has increased by a considerable amount. The disparity may be clarified. (Action: LSG Department)

Agenda No. 4 Review of Action Plans in specific cases

O.A. 681/2018 Shri Vishwa Mohan Vs CPCB:

- i. Transport Department informed that the 10 year diesel vehicles and 15 year old petrol vehicles has been banned and phased out in the NCR region falling in the Rajasthan state (Alwar & Bharatpur). Penalty and environmental compensation of Rs 500 is being collected from defaulters.
- ii. The Chief Secretary directed that the Registration Certificate of the vehicle of 10 to 15 years of these districts must be stamped informing that the vehicle is banned in the NCR region. It may also be considered that such vehicles may be seized if found running in the NCR region. (Action: Transport Department)
- iii. The state response for the Shri Bhurelal report has been submitted. The facts that there is no impact of pollution in Delhi region on the Bhiwadi area should also be reported in subsequent reports, (Action: Environment Department/ RSPCB)

O.A. 21/2014 Vardhaman Kaushik Vs Union of India:

1. Member Secretary of the State Level Committee constituted for the monitoring of the progress of implementation submitted Action Taken report which was approved after discussion. It was directed that the Member Secretary RSPCB would issue the minutes of the review meeting separately. (Action: RSPCB)

O.A. No 673/2018 Shri Jacob Koshy Vs CPCB:

- i. The action taken report w.r.t. to the Action Plan for the River Rejuvenation in the state to be submitted to Environment Department in the format prescribed by the CPCB and variables given in the order of Hon'ble NGT dated 12.09.2019. (Action: all Departments)
- ii. District Collector's must submit the District Environmental Plan within a weeks' time as directed by the CPCB so that State Level Plan may be prepared accordingly. (Action: All District Collector's)

O.A. 1038/2018 Shri Sanjay Kaw Vs CPCB:

- It was decided that The Chairperson RSPCB will hold a review meeting at his level for finalisation of the Action Plans for Pali, Jodhpur, Jaipur and Bhiwadi and will get approval of Chief Secretary on file. The approved actions plan will be submitted to CPCB thereafter. (Action: RSPCB)
- ii. Progress of project of "Up gradation of Industrial Effluent Management of Industrial Area Biwadi" may be submitted by RIICO (Action: RIICO).

O.A. No 329/ 2015 Gram Panchavat ARABA Vs State of Rajasthan:

- i. It was decided that the matter of filing an Appeal Petition in the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the directions of the Hon'ble NGT may be considered, regarding constitution of the
- Special Task Force by the Police Department. (Action: RSPCB/ Police Department). ii. Industries Department to submit the Action Plan for releasing treated water in the river (Action: Industries Department).

OA No. 804/2017 Rajiv Narayan & ANR vs. Union of India & ors

i. Labour Department to review the status of compliance of Hazardous Waste Rules submit in next monthly report to Environment Department. (Action: Labour Department).

OA No. 325/2015 Lt. Col Sarvadaman Singh Oberoi vs. Union of India & ors

- i. The information for restoration and rejuvenation of water-bodies to be submitted by LSG department. (Action: LSG Department)
