



Minutes of the 151st Board Meeting held on 14th September, 2023

151st Meeting of the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board was held on 14th September, 2023 at 02:30 PM at its Head Office, Jaipur. The following were present:-

At the outset, Member Secretary, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board, Jaipur welcomed the members of Board and briefed about structure and functioning of the State Board and the recent initiatives taken by the State Board for ease of doing business.

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Chairperson welcomed newly appointed members and requested them for their opening views, if any:-

1. Shri Narendra Khodaniya, Chairman, Sagwara raised the issue related to blooming of weed (Eichornia) in ponds of Sagwara and requested for sanction of funds for purchasing de-weeding machines. It was decided that Sagwara Nagarpalika will prepare a model wherein 50% of the cost is borne by Nagarpalika, 25% by RSPCB and 25% by State Wetland Authority with the condition that the de-weeding machine will be shared with other districts as per need.
2. Shri Shankar Chandel, Parshad, Udaipur pointed out the issue of discharge of sewage in Pichola Lake, Udaipur which is causing water pollution in the lake. He suggested that the problem may be resolved after the completion of construction of four under-construction pumping stations under Smart City Project. It was decided that the matter regarding resumption of construction work for these pumping stations will be taken up through Regional Officer, RSPCB, Udaipur.
3. Shri Ram Singh Sanju, Parshad, Jodhpur highlighted the problem of high groundwater level in Jodhpur due to seepage from lake. He also informed that earlier RUIDP had started a project for use of water of Kaylana lake in industrial area after treatment and conveyance system had been laid down but treatment plant has not been installed, yet. Given the extent of the problem, it was decided to look into it separately. He also emphasized upon the implementation of ban on single use plastic (SUP). He was briefed about the SUP items banned vide notification dated 12.08.2021, Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) scheme of Govt. of India and the EPR Cell constituted at RSPCB to ensure circularity in waste streams.
4. Shri Kewalchand Gulechha, Pali appreciated various recent initiatives of the Board and raised the issue of illegal textile processing units in Salawas, Bhandu, Balotra, between Beawar & Pali and illegal dumping of acidic water from Acid Industries situated in Abu Road. He also emphasized the poor operation and maintenance of STPs and poor utilization of treated waste water in the State. He suggested that some proportion of CSR fund be used in activities related to pollution control like establishment of Waste to Energy plant especially in Krishi Upaj Mandis to manage the problem of solid waste. He also suggested that a proportion of DMFT fund may be used in environmental related issues, only. It was decided that issues raised be looked into by concerned at the earliest.

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Thereafter, the agenda items were discussed and following decisions were taken:-
