ORDER

1. Heard the Learned Counsel for the parties and perused the record. Only contention raised by the Learned Counsel for the applicant is that the EC for M/s Himanshu Joshi (was also approximately at a distance of 26 meter) was granted by the Respondent no.1, and in an unjust arbitrary and biased ground rejected the EC of the Appellant and hence on the ground of parity, the appellant is also entitled for grant of EC. We are of the views that parity cannot be applicable in case of illegality. Thus, the appeal is not maintainable on the ground of parity. However, Learned Counsel for the Appellant has submitted that the SEIAA may be directed to reconsider the representation moved by the Appellant according to law and take a decision as per rules.
2. We direct the SEIAA that in case any representation is moved by the appellant, that may be disposed of according to rules within a reasonable time.

The appeal is disposed of, accordingly.
