ORDER

1. Grievance in this application moved by Smt. Meenu Kanwar Rathore, Pradhan, Panchayat Samiti, Andheri Devri Panchayat Samit, Masuda, Ajmer is against illegal mining and blasting in Aravali Hills and grazing land at the land leased to Shree Cement Ltd., at various places like Khempura, Lulwa, Naadi, Jhak, Shyamgarh in Rajasthan. This illegal mining has caused damage to the houses located nearby and is resulting in lowering of ground water.

2. In view of the above, we direct the State PCB and District Magistrate-Ajmer, Rajasthan to look into the grievance in this application. The State PCB will be the Nodal agency for coordination and compliance. The Joint Committee may meet within four weeks and

undertake site visit and look into the grievance. Factual and action taken report may be furnished within three months before the Ld. Registrar General, NGT, Delhi by e-mail at judicial-ngt@gov.in preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF and, if necessary, he may put the matter before the Bench for necessary directions.

The application stands disposed of.
