The Hon'ble Prime Minister, in his 39th edition of "Mann ki Baat" on 31st December 2017, inspired citizens, specially the youth - of the country to participate in Swachh Survekshan-2018 (SS-18).

2. As you are aware, the SS-18 the third edition of Swatchh Survekshan, is the largest survey of its kind in the world, impacting 40 crores citizens of 4041 cities across the country and will rank cities (approx 500) with population of 1 lakh and above on national level, and remaining cities with population less than 1lakh. This survey has commenced from 4th January and shall go on till 10th March, 2018.

3. The major focus of the SS-18 is on sustainability of solutions to serve the cities and remain outcomes oriented rather than process oriented. A new feature of "Innovation" has been added with 5% weightage in this year survey. A brief on the parameters to be covered in the Survey, their weightage, and methodology of evaluation is attached (Annex).

4. Citizens participation and their feedback is a critical component of this survey with weightage of 35% reinforcing that active participation of citizens is crucial in deciding their cities ranking. Therefore, strategic use of print media, electronic media like TV and radio, social media and IEC creatives on SBM portal has been undertaken at the national level. It has also been decided to organise 100 Interpersonal communication (IPC) events through the Directorate of Field Publicity (DFP) in cities having populations of 5 lakh and above. Cities also have undertaken massive IEC and IPC activities.

Swachh Survekshan

Almost 3 years ago, on 2 October 2014, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India launched Swachh Bharat Mission(Urban) with two very ambitious objectives to be achieved by 2 October 2019 – FIRST, to make India open defection free and SECOND, to ensure 100% scientific processing of municipal solid waste.

Barely few months after Swachh Bharat Mission came into existence, to ensure that it sees the light of the day and monitor the progress in urban landscape, the Ministry followed a very innovative approach that helped integrating all cities in achieving common goals set out by the Ministry.

In October, 2015, the Swachh Bharat Mission team in the Ministryconceptualized and introduced a healthy competition 'Swachh Survekshan' among cities to improve the status of urban sanitation in India.

- Swachh Survekshan-2016 conducted in January, 2016 assessing 73 Urban Local Bodies.
 Mysuru got the tag of Cleanest City of India...and one year later...
- Next surveySwachh Survekshan-2017 was conducted out in January-February 2017 covering 434 ULBs. Indore emerged as the Cleanest City of India.

During declaration of the Swachh Survekshan-2017 results on 4th May, 2017, it was announced that all **4041** cities will be part of **Swachh Survekshan-2018** to be conducted from January to March, 2018.

The methodology of the survey focuses on collection of data from 3 sources:

- Service Level Progress: This will carry 35% weightage in the survey, where ULB's
 documents are physically verified to assess whether systems and processes are in place
 to implement Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) in the most efficient way.
- Direct Observation: will have 30% weightage to observe and ascertain general cleanliness in the cities by making random field visits in different parts of the city and public conveniences covering Community/Public Toilets.
- 3. <u>Citizens Feedback</u>: has been given 35% weightage to diagnose the experience of the citizens –city's pulse is checked by collecting citizens response against 6 specific questions covering issues around general cleanliness and sanitation related progress made by the city. <u>SwachhataApp</u>, a grievance mechanism tool handed over to citizens also contributes in indicating the efforts made by the cities in resolving the issues raised by the citizens. Till date more than 49 lakh citizens have downloaded the App.

Some of the examples of outcome based parameters are

- Indicators regarding notification of User charges have been changed from issuing notification to collection of User Charges
- Indicators asking whether city has compost plant to whether City's registering Production
 and Marketing details of the Compost
- Linkage of attendance with payroll and incentives
- Recognition of drivers/contractorstransporting municipal solid waste linked with GPS basedmonitoring
- ICT Based Monitoring of Community/Public Toilets

Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, on 31 December 2017, in his 'Mann Ki Baat' program, also called upon the people, particularly the younger generation, to participate in the Swachh Survekshan-2018 and take it to another level. It is not for the government alone to maintain cleanliness. Every citizen and people's organisations have a big responsibility and take the full onus to ensure that your city should not lag behind.

Swachh Survekshan has served as the agent of change demonstrating massive potential of addressing challenges through unique interventions in urban governance. It inculcates the spirit of healthy competition and focuses on the ability of cities not only to perform but also outperform other cities. With the roll out of Swachh Survekshan-2018, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs have conviction that with the ownership of sanitation being undertaken by Cities, urban India will become cleaner with more sensitive and responsive citizens of India will achieve 'Swachh India' vision of our Father of Nation before 2nd October, 2019.
